### JOB SUMMARY

Under direction to perform maintenance of MST's rolling stock to insure continued safe operation.

### ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Safety inspection; lubrication; changing tires; engine and transmission work; electrical and air-conditioning work; body work; other maintenance duties as required.

### KNOWLEDGE & ABILITY

Ability to follow written and verbal instructions; ability to qualify for Class B license; ability to work with a Windows operating system and daily data entry in a Maintenance Department software system is required; familiarity with all phases of vehicle maintenance; familiarity with MST service area; ability to perform required duties. Knowledge and experience with diesel and gasoline engines desirable.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

Graduation from high school or GED equivalent. **Excellent driving record**; licensed driver for 5 years; must possess valid California driver's license at time of application and meet all qualifications specified by the State of California for a Class B Drivers License; In accordance with the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, must be prepared to offer documents to support employment eligibility; willingness to work outside.

**If hired**, must pass a post offer pre-employment drug screening and DMV required physical examination; must pass vehicle controls test; obtain a Class B **instruction permit** with air-brakes certification, **or** possess a valid Class B license, participate in random drug and alcohol testing as mandated by the Department of Transportation and join Local 1225 of Amalgamated Transit Union.
