SEPTEMBER EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board adopted Resolution 2009-05 recognizing Paul Lopez, Facilities Technician, as Employee of the Month for August 2008. Paul was instrumental in the cleanup of a large fuel spill at the Wright Division. He worked together with the Facilities staff to remove over sixty gallons of fuel – this minimized the impact to MST. He and others painted and striped the parking lot to provide the bus training team a safe and accurate reproduction of a specific traffic intersection at Central and Lincoln in Salinas.
