MAY EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2014-20 recognizing Dave Bielsker, transit scheduler, as the May Employee of the Month for his positive contribution to MST and to the entire community.

RECEIVE 2014-2016 TITLE VI PLAN AND ADOPT RESOLUTION 2014-21

Under Consent Agenda, the MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2014-21 approving the 2014-2016 Title VI Plan Update.

AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF IT SERVICE TRUCK

Under Consent Agenda, the MST Board unanimously approved the purchase of one service truck, not to exceed \$27,000, for IT staff from Hanford Toyota, Sacramento. The vehicle is identified for purchase and budgeted in the FY 2014 budget.

ADOPT THE MST CONTINUITY OF OPERATIONS PLAN

Under Consent Agenda, the MST Board unanimously adopted the MST Continuity of Operations Plan to direct and guide appropriate and probable actions in the event of a wide range of emergency situations.

APPROVE FREE FARES FOR ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY WITH ID ON LINE EIGHTY-ONE.

The MST Board unanimously approved providing free fares for active duty military personnel utilizing Line 81 to travel from San Jose to the military installation. The military is providing 45% of the cost of the project and a special federal grant will fund the remaining 55%.
